INVESTMENT REPORT

Strategy

The Certificate aims to achieve optimal capital growth over the long term through the active management of a portfolio comprising mainly listed companies based in developed markets.

The investment strategy is based on a fundamental analysis: the stock selection process is based mainly on the activity of companies, their governance, financial structure, and development prospects. The Certificate aims, primarily, to identify companies with dominant positions, high reinvestment capacity, and low debt.

The recommended investment horizon is 5 years. The reference currency of the Certificate is the Euro, but the Certificate also invests in other currencies including the US Dollar, the Japanese Yen and the Swiss Franc.

Over the month, American and European markets experienced varied performances, influenced by economic and political factors. In the US, the S&P 500 is down -2.50%, the Nasdaq 100 is up +0.39%, and the Dow Jones Industrial Average is down -5.27%. In Europe, the Euro Stoxx 50 up +1.91%, the Stoxx Europe 600 down -0.52%, and the CAC 40 up +2.01%.

Sector wise, in the US; the Automobile Manufacturers Sector was up strongly at +14.61% (thanks, Tesla), while the Steel Sector lost -23.44%. In Europe, the Consumer Products & Services Sector led the charge at +5.95%, while the Real Estate Sector lost -5.23%.

The Certificate

FFM Global Quality was down -1.11% during the month, slightly underperforming the MSCI World EUR, which was down -0.69%.

The monthly top three consisted of Palantir (+15.03%), Alphabet (+14.44%), and Hermès (+12.45%). On the other side, we find Uber (-14.48%), BWX Technologies (-13.15%), and Vistra (-12.36%).

During the month, we sold Sonova, Linde, and Atlas Copco, reduced Palantir and increased Alphabet, and bought Salesforce, Vistra, and Broadcom.


